CIMT 272 – Introduction to Classroom Computer Use *(Taught Spring 1999, Fall 1999, Spring 2000, Fall 2000, Spring 2001, Spring 2002)* (Co-taught with Dr. Susan Powers)

This course is designed to familiarize undergraduate education students with the microcomputer as an instructional tool.

CIMT 657 – Computer Projects *(Taught Summer 2000, Summer 2001)*

This course the student chooses computer projects with the approval and guidance of the instructor. The number of projects is determined by complexity, ability, software, and hardware available.

CIMT 672 – Multimedia Authoring *(Taught Spring 2000, Spring 2004, Fall 2006, Spring 2008)*

This course students will become proficient and competent in one authoring tool environment to create a multimedia program that may be used in education or training.

CIMT 678 - Teachers Workshop *(Taught Summer 2003, Summer 2004)*

This course provides opportunities for teachers to use recently developed procedures to study and improve teaching.

CIMT 687 - Leading and Managing Technology Resources in Educational Settings *(Taught Fall 2004, Spring 2006, Fall 2007)*

This course provides the participant with the knowledge of and ability to plan, lead, manage, budget, make decisions and implement technology support for instruction which includes; the selection, supervision, training and evaluation of staff; identification, evaluation, selection, acquisition, maintenance and use of instructional technology systems; facility design to support technology enhanced instruction; and funding sources to support technology in educational settings, including grants.

COUN 595Q – Special Topics in Counseling: Technology for School Counselors *(Taught Summer 2001, Summer 2002, Summer 2003, Summer 2004, Summer 2005, Summer 2007, Summer 2008)*

This course introduces school counselor students to how technology can be used in their profession.

EDUO 802 Transforming Education through Technology *(Taught Fall 2019)*

This course explores technology tools, applications, media, and environments in education, to stimulate positive changes in education. It also examines how educators can increase productivity by using technology to accomplish 21st century learning objectives for communication, collaboration and creativity among colleagues, staff, parents, students, and the larger community.

MIS 372 – Management of Business Systems Development (*Taught Spring 2013, Spring 2015, Spring 2020*)

This course is an introduction to business systems development concepts and methodologies from a project management approach. The course covers a variety of business systems development topics including how to view a firm as a system, IT infrastructure, project management, systems development stages, process modeling, data modeling, object modeling, and design pattern with the latest design tools.

LDRS 614 – Change Leadership (*Spring 2016, Fall 2019, Spring 2020*)

This course focuses on basic theory and skills for the management and leadership of public and non-profit organizations (including schools) to impact the growth, sustainability, and integrity of organizations.

LDRS 646 – Leadership and Technology (*Taught Fall 2014, Fall 2015, Fall 2016, Fall 2017, Fall 2018, Summer 2019, Summer 2020*)

This course covers how technology plays a vital role in an organization, including: collaboration, communication, and organizing knowledge. Learners in this course will use tools and techniques to improve group effectiveness, feedback strategies, and individual content/knowledge management. Utilizing these technologies, learners focus on effective communication, develop assessment techniques, and devise a toolbox of strategies for facilitating projects and meetings.
